


Photo from "Point Loma" book.

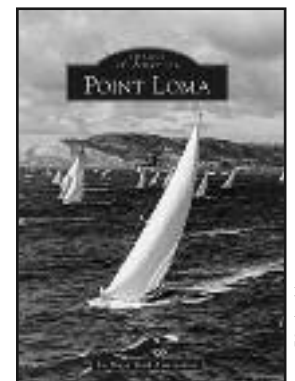
