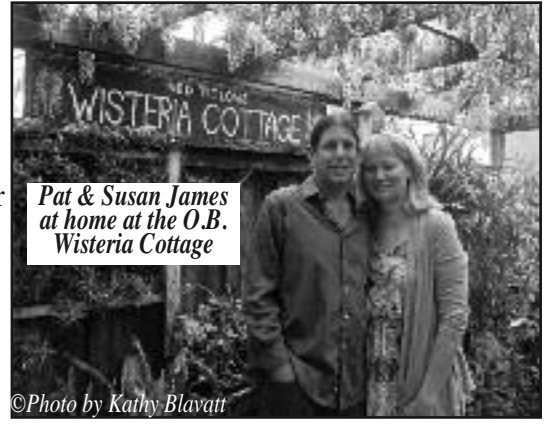

REMEMBERING CAROL... CAROL ANN HART BOWERS




Carol Bowers passed away on January 4, 2017, at 82. She was born on June 8, 1934, to George and Esmerelda in La Jolla. Carol grew up on Newport Avenue, between Santa Babara and Venice and attended local schools.

A writer and publisher Carol of Ocean Beach, co-founded the Ocean Beach Historical Society in 1994; and was one of the organization’s early presidents. For many years, she designed, wrote, and published the society’s Sea Scrolls newsletter, while at the same time writing local history articles for area newspapers. The book, “The Passing Parade: True Tales of Ocean Beach History,” for instance, contains several of Carol’s entertaining articles about the exciting past of her beloved home town. Carol was also the owner/editor of Tecolote Publishers, and as such published over 100 books many on local history topics.

One of these books, “Three Beams of Light,” is the true account of a lighthouse keeper’s family that lived at Ballast Point. Prior to going into business for herself, Carol worked as an assistant editor for Copley Books. She also conducted a weekly writers’ workshop in Ocean Beach for a number of years.

We will hold Carol in our memories and are thankful for her commitment to preserving the history of Ocean Beach.
